2024–2025 Evaluation Summary



St. Francis Neighborhood Center (SFNC) is a 62-year-old community-based organization located in Reservoir Hill. SFNC is committed to ending generational poverty through education, inspiring self-esteem and self-improvement, and strengthening connections to the community.

Achievements



71% of Grade K-8 students demonstrated growth in English Language Arts.

72% of Grade K-8 students demonstrated growth in math.



61% of K-8 students demonstrated an attendance rate of at least 80%.



66% of Grade K-8 students improved their engagement in learning during SY 2024-25.

69% of Grade K-8 students improved their engagement in learning during summer 2025.



Opportunities

1. Completion of the expansive construction on its facility this year
2. High levels of program engagement by Grade K–8 students during the school year (98% of enrollees were regular attendees) and summer (90% of enrollees were regular attendees)



Recommendations



- Enforce the report card policy and use ClassDojo for teacher-parent communication to ensure consistent data collection.
- Create a priority list of low-performing students after each testing cycle and coordinate schedules to ensure they receive tutoring first.
